I am pleased to provide a Chairman's Report for the year ending 30 June, 2023. The Objectives and Mission of RCRR Enterprises Ltd., in its capacity as a charity, is to consider and if appropriate, approve grant applications and donations to various local, regional and national entities, to:

- promote reconciliation, mutual respect, and tolerance between groups of individuals that are in Australia,
- promote or protect human rights,
- provide other similar purpose 'beneficial to the general public'.


The company gains its revenue from the operations of the Rotary Opportunity Warehouse retail business conducted at 26 Henry Wilson Drive, Rosebud (and from July 2023 the separate Rotary Op Shop business located near the Rosebud Shopping Plaza).

The 'Warehouse' property is leased from the Rotary Club of Rosebud-Rye Inc. (the Op Shop premises is rented under a commercial agreement from independent owners).

The Board of RCRR Enterprises Ltd, comprises: Chairman - Paul Mee, Secretary/Director - Heather Barton AM, Treasurer/Director - Philip Hedley, Directors - Gael Traa, Claire Burns, Bernard Wong and Barry Irving OAM. Elizabeth Wilson is an ex-officio board member and General Manager.

It gives me pleasure to report that over the past 12 months, the Rotary Warehouse business and the company have performed well above our expectations.

The company has achieved a sound net financial surplus and has sound balance sheet equity as at 30 June 2023. Please refer to the accompanying company financial statements for the full details. A substantial part of this success would not be achieved without the professional leadership and passionate commitment of our Rotary Warehouse General Manager Elizabeth (Libby) Wilson. We should also thank Secretary Heather Barton, Treasurer Philip Hedley, banking officer Bernard Wong, our Administration Officer Sandi Kenny-Row and our wonderful volunteers.

The Warehouse business is a fantastic example of recycling and repurposing furniture and the full range of household items that in many cases would be destined for landfill. We also recycle and sell clothing, books, and second-hand goods. Congratulations to our dedicated volunteers led by the Warehouse Supervisors Russell, Sharon, Marilyn and Ian.

During the past year the Rotary Warehouse has received several calls for help and happily we were able to donate 'fridges, washing machines, furniture and good quality second hand goods to families in need, in our local community. Our 'donations in kind' value exceeded \$5,000 for the year.

From net revenue this year we have provided over \$126,000 in grants and donations to local, regional and national community service causes. Our reach and impact have been particularly focussed on youth and youth programs this year.

Recipient organisations for our grants and donations include:

- Rye Community House childcare equipment
- Rotary National Youth Science Forum (NYSF) sponsored 2 students to attend 2-week forum
- Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) sponsored 2 students and 1 leader to attend a one-week leadership development camp
- Rosebud Secondary College student scholarships and hardship student scholarships
- Rosebud, Rye, Tootgarook, Boneo and Eastbourne Primary Schools student scholarships

- Australian Rotary Health (ARH) Mental Health Research and post-graduate scholarships in health
- Parkinson's Australia to aid research
- Rotary and Capel Sound Foreshores Committee construction of Capel Sound BBQ Shelter, as part of the Peninsula Trail project with Mornington Peninsula Shire
- Rosebud Secondary College Mentoring program for wellbeing
- Eastbourne Primary School equipment for new Wellness Centre
- Gippsland Rotary Centenary House Traralgon donation of a defibrillator

We are very proud to report another successful year for this charitable enterprise. RCRR Enterprises Ltd. is set up well to continue its objectives, funding worthwhile causes and providing relief and assistance to people in need in our community.

With the support of our Rotary Club members, our fabulous volunteers, and the community, we are looking forward to the coming year.

The business achieved an operating profit for the year (before donations) of \$111,000, compared to \$58,000 last year.


